### WORK EXPERIENCE:

**Toxicology consultant:** 1991 – present, currently involved in alcohol and drug related cases in Federal, Circuit and General District courts throughout Virginia. Testified almost two thousand times during career. Purchased Intoxilyzer 5000 in 1998, performed over three hundred breath alcohol analyses and qualified as expert witness in issues concerning the Intoxilyzer in Circuit and Federal Courts over twenty-five times.

**Registered Pharmacist:** 1960 – present. 1960 to 1963, practiced with the United States Public Health Service in New Orleans, LA and Tahlequah, OK. Duties included supervision of Pharmacy Services in Tahlequah and assistance in clinical toxicology emergencies. Currently practicing pharmacy with CVS in Roanoke.

**Forensic Toxicologist:** 1967-1991. Served the western counties and cities of Virginia. Duties included the analysis of blood and other specimens submitted by the medical examiners for alcohol, drugs and poisons, interpreting the results for submitting agencies, and testifying in judicial proceedings. Developed analytical procedures, trained chemists in the Toxicology section and served as Regional Director of the Western Division of Forensic Sciences for a period of time.

**Forensic Toxicologist:** 1966-1967. Employed at the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, practicing in Richmond, VA awaiting completion of Western Division facility in Roanoke. Duties included supervision of toxicology laboratory section in absence of Chief Toxicologist, analysis of specimens, development of analytical procedures and testifying in court.

**Laboratory Technologist:** 1963- 1966. Worked as laboratory technologist in Toxicology section of Richmond office of the Chief Medical Examiner while attending the graduate program at Medical College of Virginia. Duties included the analysis of specimens under supervision, maintenance of analytical instruments, and preparation of reagents.
