The reason is that there are several hundred known cannabinoids and different strains of pot have varying amounts of these. Some of the potent strains today are remarkably different than the strains of the 70's. Some are "mellow", some are "speedy" depending on the varying amounts of different cannabinoids. Each strain has its own personality, so to speak. Cannabinoids should be isolated and studied. Some strains lack a psychic effect; they give a "body high". As Grinspoon points out, these would probably be classified as schedule 4, thus lessening their criminality. Perhaps in the future there could be a legal hybrid, although like most fans, I would prefer all marijuana de- criminalised. As Bob Marley sang: legalise it!
